The Concert Series



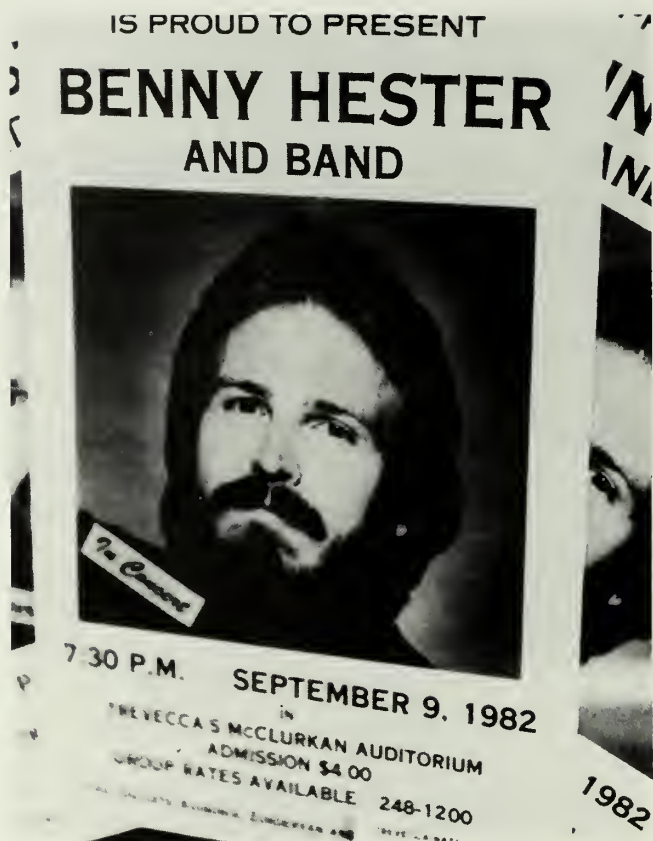

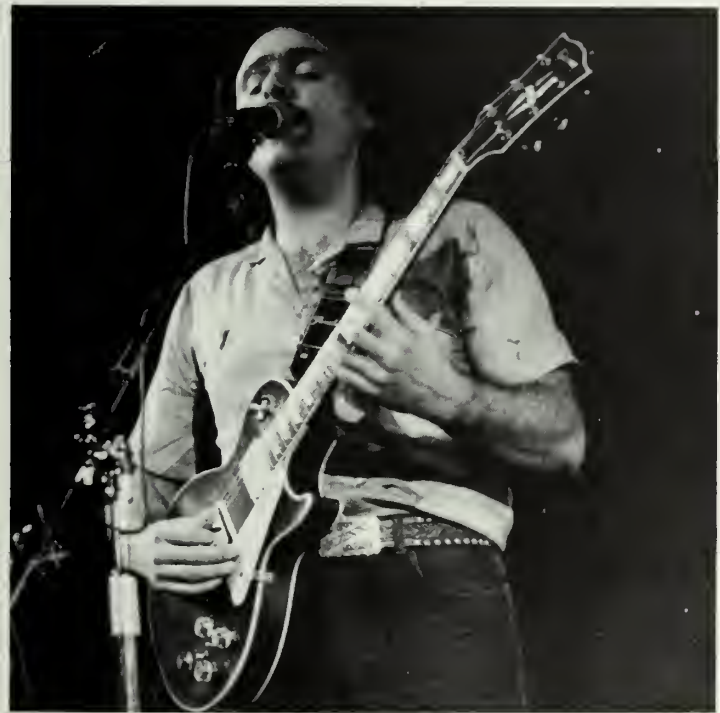
Joe English

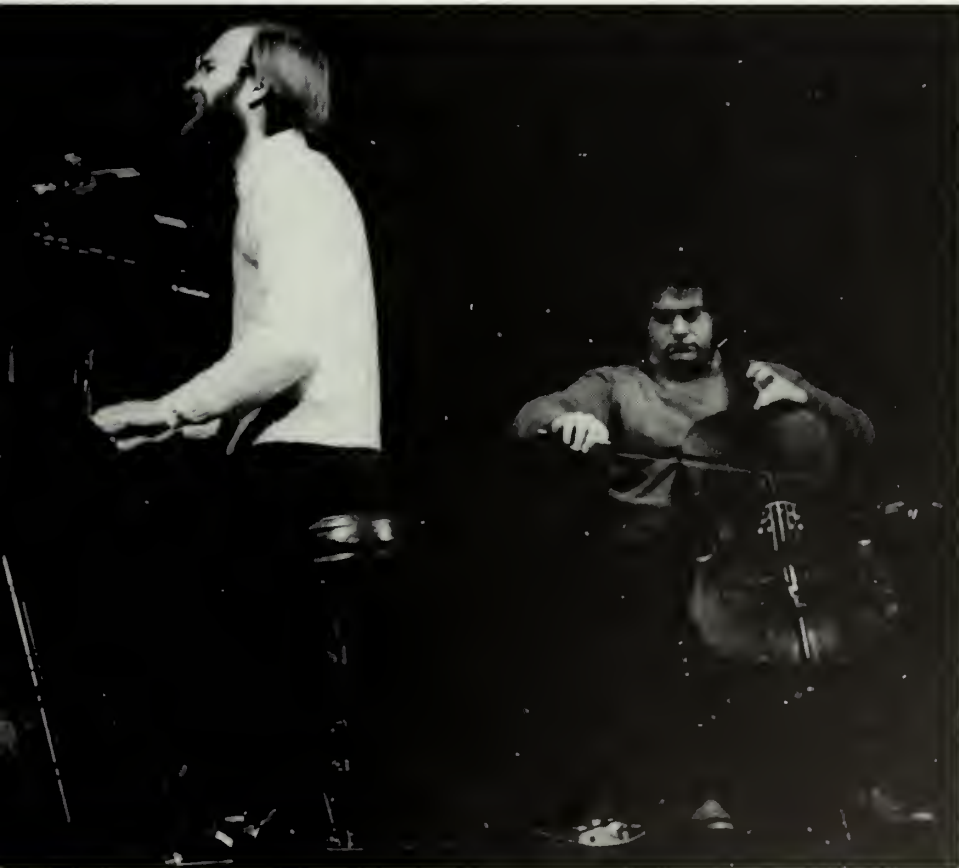
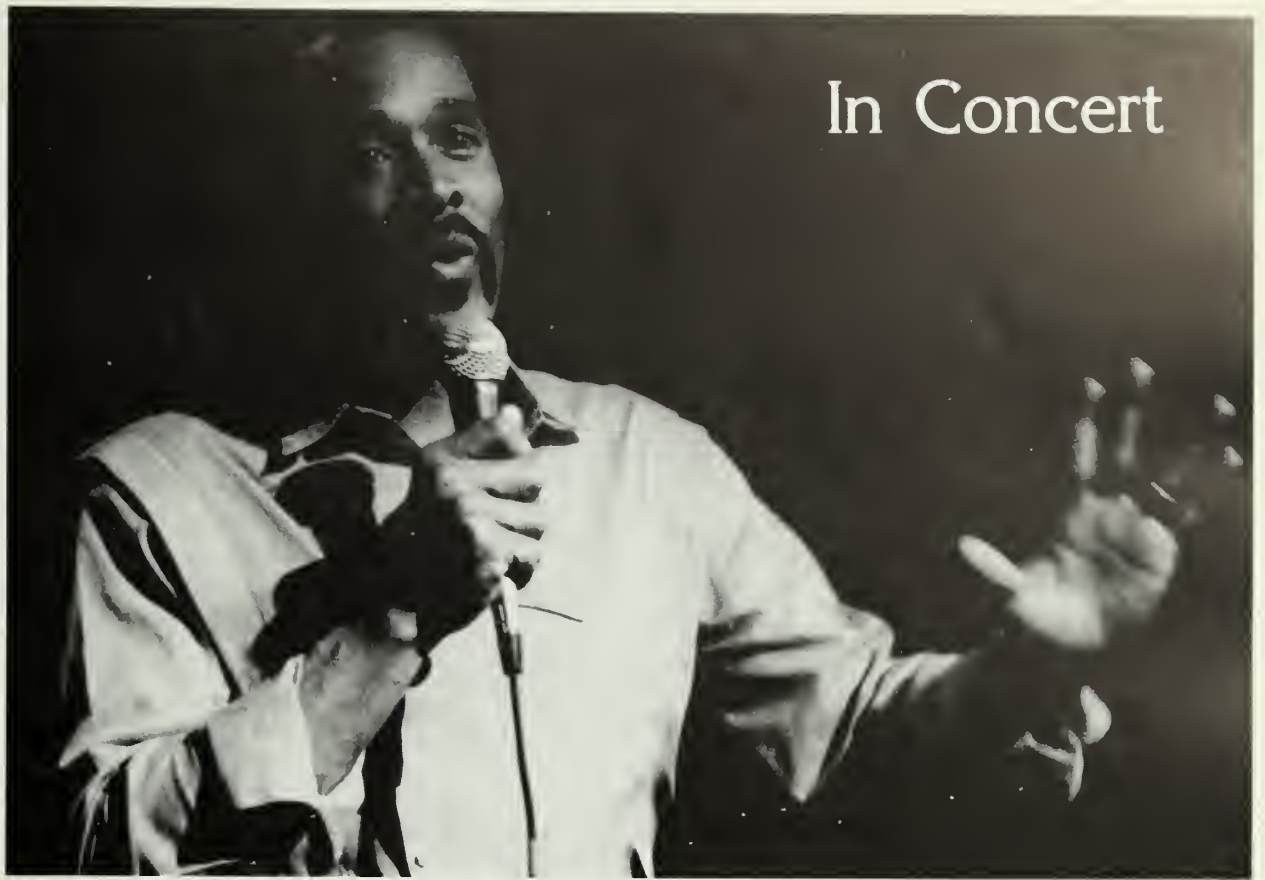


Leon Patillo

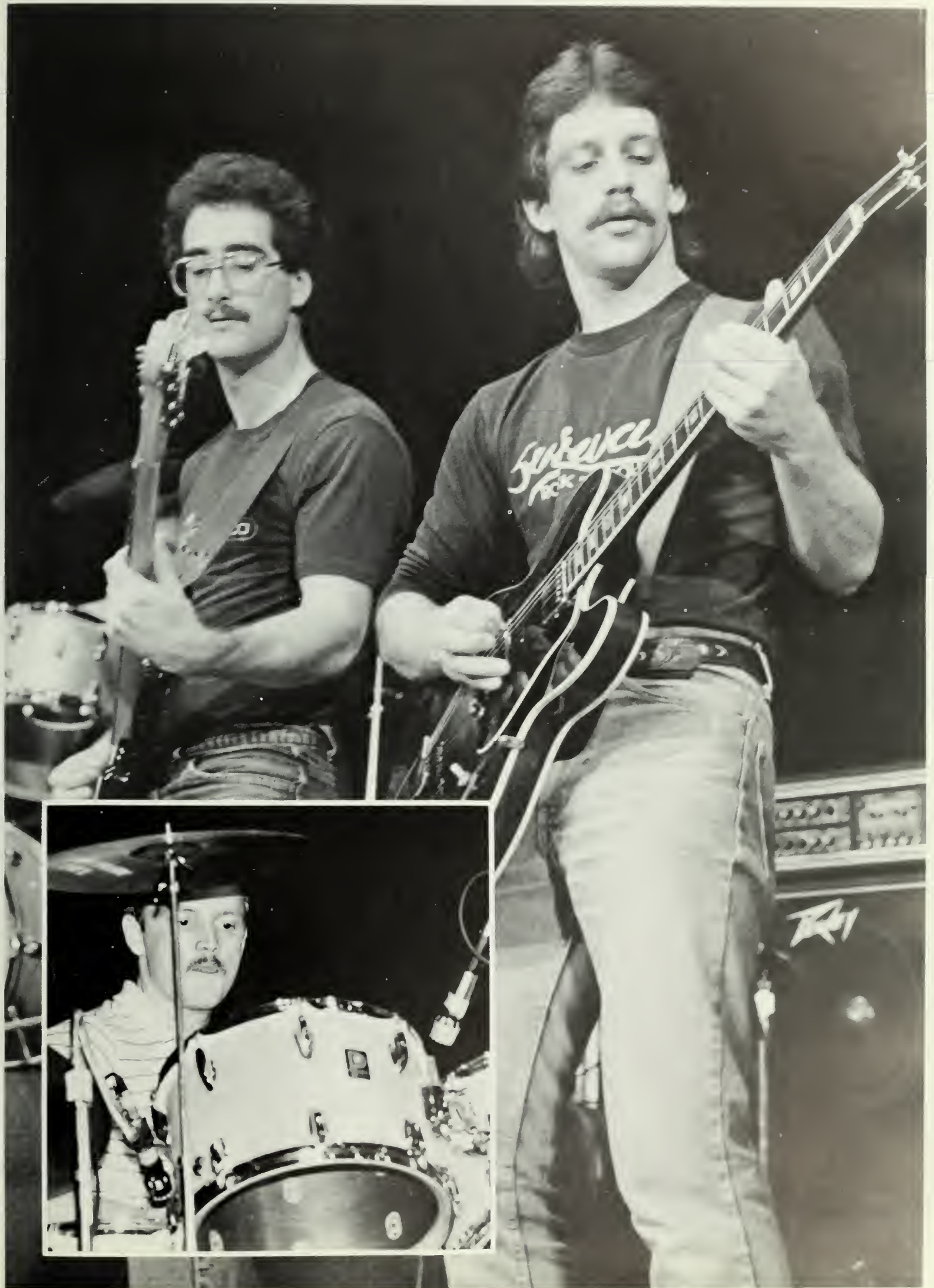

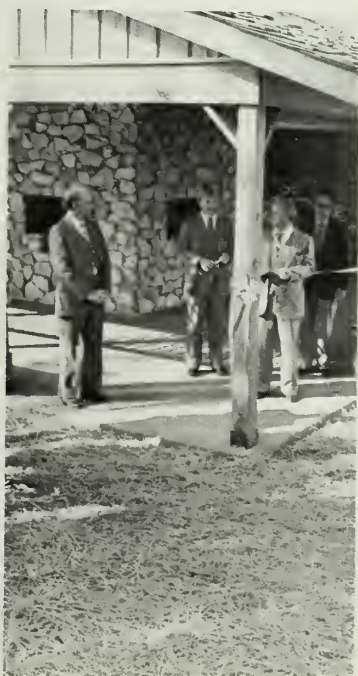

Picnic Pavilion Dedication



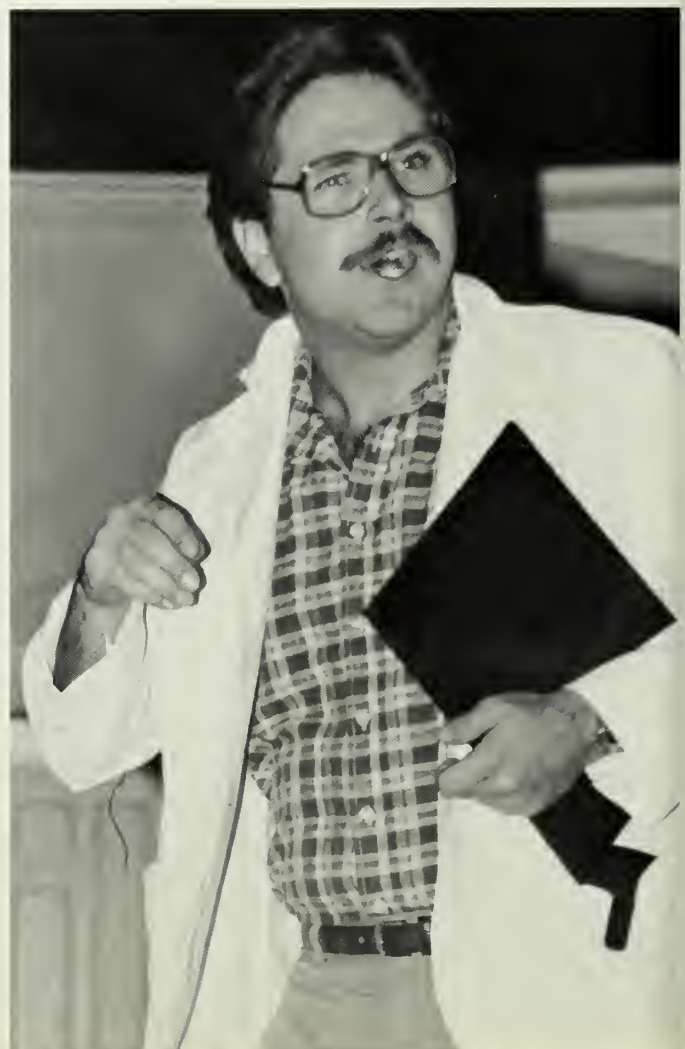

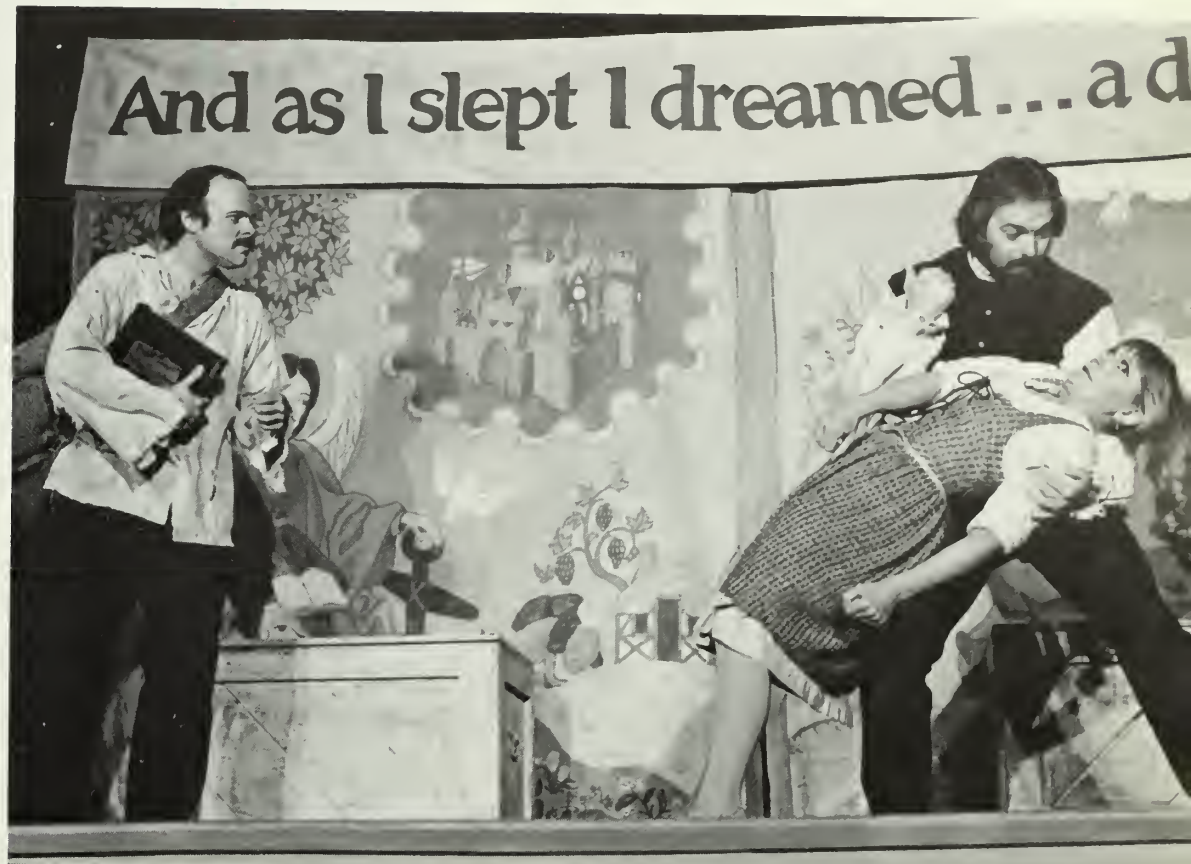
Hicks & Cohagen
